Dear David:

As per my earlier email, the Meriwether County Water and Sewerage Authority has requested that we modify both the agreement regarding construction of the plant as well as the agreement for treatment to reflect the new construction schedule. In essence, the amendments modify the substantial completion date to March 1, 2018, and update the agreements to provide that the 30-year term of each will be begin upon substantial completion of the Project, as opposed to seven years ago when the Project was first anticipated.

As we discussed, Authority attorney Bob Trammell suggested these modifications, which are entirely logical. Under the circumstances, if feasible, I would suggest that we take up the amendments at the earliest opportunity, since the suggested changes are minor and also to our benefit.
