

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY; TO MODIFY CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE RELATING TO UTILITY TAP FEES; TO PROVIDE THAT A TAP FEE PURCHASE SHALL ALLOW FOR INSTALLATION WITHIN TWO YEARS OF PURCHASE WITHOUT FEE MODIFICATION; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO FIX AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1:

That Section 98-35 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hogansville is hereby amended by inserting therein a new subsection (i) to read as follows:

“(i) The City may from time-to-time, modify the price of utility tap fees as referenced herein. The customer shall pay the tap fee as adopted by the mayor and council and in force as of the date said tap is purchased. No increase in the tap fee shall apply unless said tap is not installed within two years from the date of purchase. For taps installed over two years from the payment of a tap fee, the customer must pay the difference resulting from any fee increase.”

SECTION 2:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance, after adoption by the Council and upon approval by the Mayor, shall become effective immediately.
