



CALLED MEETING

Thursday, July 25, 2019 – 6pm

A Called Meeting of the Hogansville City Council was held on Thursday, July 25, 2019. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stankiewicz at 6pm.

Present were Mayor William Stankiewicz, Council Member Reginald Jackson, Council Member Marichal Price, Council Member Fred Higgins, Council Member George Bailey, and Council Member Theresa Strickland. Also, present were City Manager David Milliron, City Clerk Lisa Kelly, Chief of Police Brian Harr, and Community Development Director Lynne Miller.

Motion: Council Member Higgins moved to adopt the agenda as amended, seconded by Council Member Jackson.

Discussion: Request was made by City Manager David Milliron to add #4, under business, Sewer Main – Villages at Huntcliff Subdivision, as an information item only. **Roll Call Vote:** Jackson (Yea), Price (Not Yet Present), Higgins (Yea), Bailey (Yea), Strickland (Yea)

Motion Passes 4-0

BUSINESS

1. USDA Rural Development Funds – Patrol Vehicles.

Motion: Council Member Strickland moved to adopt the resolution securing funding for \$87k in loan and \$50k in grant funding for three police cruisers and security cameras for two parks on Pine Street & Green Avenue. Council Member Higgins seconded the motion.

Discussion: None

Roll Call Vote: Jackson (Yea), Price (Yea), Higgins (Yea), Bailey (Yea), Strickland (Yea)

Motion Passes 5-0

2. USDA-Funded Waste Water Treatment Plant Funding.

Motion: None

Discussion: USDA Rural Development is requiring the City to expend the \$1.6m in funds contributed by Meriwether County Water & Sewerage Authority prior to drawing down funds from any other source until such funds are depleted.

3. Council Update – Winslett Drive Water Pressure Issues.

Motion: None

Discussion: Water Department crews will begin repairs next week on a section of Winslett Drive experiencing low water pressure derived from previous repairs over five years ago, whereby a 10” main was dropped to a 6” main and then back to 10”, creating a bottleneck.

4. Sewer Main – Villages at Huntcliff.

Motion: None

Discussion: Emergency stabilization is underway for a portion of collapsed sewer line, running across Yellow Jacket Creek behind the subdivision. Bids are being accepted and will be brought before Council at the August 5, 2019 meeting for approval.
