

**City of Hogansville**  
**Lake Jimmy Jackson Park Rules & Regulations**  
Proposed 3/18/2019

The following general daily use rules and regulations are for Lake Jimmy Jackson Park. These rules also apply to anyone attending a special event at the Park.

- A. A personal flotation device must be worn when boating.
- B. Alcohol is prohibited. No persons shall bring alcohol into the Park.
- C. Amplified music is not permitted unless authorized in writing by the City Manager.
- D. Bicycles will be allowed in the Park only on paved areas or paths designated for that purpose. Bicycles are not allowed on the boat launch or dock.
- E. Building of fires is prohibited.
- F. Camping is not allowed in the Park.
- G. Damaging, defacing or removing any plant, animal, natural feature, object, sign structure, equipment or other material is strictly prohibited.
- H. Firearms, slingshots, bows and arrows, and guns of any kind are strictly prohibited in the Park.
- I. Fishing is permitted in the Park. A valid Georgia fishing license will be required per the Georgia Department of Conservation requirements.
- J. Glass bottles of any kind are not allowed in the Park. Waste paper, aluminum cans, tin cans, rubbish, and debris of all kinds shall be deposited in the containers provided for that purpose in the Park. All areas shall be left in a clean and orderly condition.
- K. Indecent language, excessively loud noise, disorderly conduct, immoral actions or nudity is not permitted.
- L. It is unlawful to hurt, molest, harm, trap, kill, shoot or release any animal, reptile or bird in the Park.
- M. No person in the Park shall drive in any area except parking lots and shall not drive at a rate of speed in excess of ten (10) miles per hour.
- N. No person shall enter an area building, or roadway in the Park posted "No Admittance" or "Closed to the Public."
- O. No Smoking.
- P. Only non-motorized watercraft are permitted in the lake, including Kayaks, Canoes, Paddle Boats, Windsurfers, Row Boats, and Long Boards. Inflatable, motorized watercrafts and personal watercrafts/water scooters are not permitted.
- Q. Pets shall not be permitted in the Park unless they are on a secured leash. Animal waste should be collected by the owner. Pets are not allowed on the beach or in the lake.
- R. Solicitation of any business or service in city parks is prohibited. No person, firm or corporation is permitted to offer or advertise merchandise or other goods for sale or hire in the Park unless part of a permitted activity by the City Manager.
- S. Swimming in the Lake is allowed from the beach area only.
- T. The park shall be open to the public from dawn until dusk unless otherwise designated.
- U. Use of barbeque grills, portable grills or deep fryers is not permitted except with written approval from the City Manager.
- V. Use of metal detectors is prohibited.
