The Regular Meeting of the Hogansville City Council was held on Monday, February 4, 2019. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stankiewicz at 7:48p.m.

Present were Mayor Bill Stankiewicz, Council Member Reginald Jackson, Council Member Fred Higgins, and Council Member Theresa Strickland. Also present were City Manager David Milliron, City Clerk Lisa Kelly, and Chief of Police Brian Harr. Rev. Earnestine Mitchell gave the invocation and Mayor Stankiewicz led the pledge.

On a motion by Council Member Higgins and dually seconded by Council Member Strickland, the agenda was approved 3-0.

1. Phase II Hydrant Replacement. Motion by Higgins to accept the proposal by Crawford Grading for hydrant replacement in the amount of \$46,956, seconded by Jackson. Carried 3-0

1. Special Use Permit – Group Home. Motion by Jackson to table the item until the next regular meeting, seconded by Higgins. Carried 3-0
2. Resolution – CDBG 2019 Application. Motion by Higgins to adopt the resolution authorizing application for the 2019 Community Development Block Grant.
3. Board Appointments
 - a. Meriwether Joint Development Authority. Motion by Jackson to re-appoint all existing Hogansville members of the board as recommended by the Meriwether County Industrial Park Executive Board, seconded by Strickland. Carried 3-0

There being no further business to come before the Mayor & Council of the City of Hogansville at this time, on a motion made and dually seconded, the meeting was adjourned at 8:36pm.
