



WORK SESSION

A Work Session of the Hogansville City Council was held on Monday, October 7, 2018. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stankiewicz at 5p.m.

Present were Mayor Bill Stankiewicz, Council Member Marichal Price, Council Member Fred Higgins, Council Member George Bailey, Council Member Theresa Strickland. Also present were City Manager David Milliron, and City Clerk Lisa Kelly. Council Member Jackson was not present for tonight's meeting.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. Discussion of City Financials. City Accountant, Dawn Goins presented the August 2019 financials summarizing the position of each fund.
2. SPLOST-Funded Pavilion(s) for Lake Jimmy Jackson. Council Members were updated with the status on up to three 20'x20' concrete pavilions with picnic tables at a cost of \$28,725 each. Funding will be supplied by the City's portion of Parks & Recreation matched SPLOST funds. The funds are not readily available now but will trickle in monthly over time. Additional plans to add bike racks and grills are still in place. This is an agenda item for the upcoming meeting and a decision will need to be made on the number of pavilions to be placed on the property.
3. Misc.
 - a. Roadside furniture and debris was discussed. Code Enforcement is working diligently to get results with items that are not allowed to be picked up per the ordinance and are being dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Customers in violation are given the required ten days to comply and follow ups are occurring regularly. The new sanitation ordinance has a slight delay with items the landfill will and will not allow the City to dump.

The Work Session was adjourned 6:05pm.
