The City's appointed Historic Preservation Commission has 5 members, but many local HPC's have 7, and the Hogansville would like to do so also. This would enable the HPC to bring more talent and interested citizens to this committee. City Council would appoint these 2 additional members after recommendation from the Historic Preservation Commission.

AN AMENDMENT TO EXISTING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY; TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY; TO MODIFY AND AMEND THE CURRENT HOGANSVILLE HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE IN ORDER TO EXPAND THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MEMBERS TO SEVEN AND TO STAGGER TERMS OF SERVICE OF SUCH MEMBERS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO FIX AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1:

That the code of the City of Hogansville be amended by deleting therefrom Chapter 46, in its entirety.

SECTION 2:

That Division 6 of Article III of Chapter 102, the Zoning Ordinance of the City, be amended by deleting Sub-section (c) of Section102-373 of Division 6, inserting in lieu thereof a new Subsection (e) of Section 102-373 of Division 6, to read as follows:

Sec. 102-373. - Creation of A Historic Preservation Commission.

(c) Commission members: number, appointment, terms and compensation. The commission shall consist of a minimum of three (3) members and a maximum of seven (7) members, with such members to be appointed by the Mayor and ratified by the City Council. All members shall be residents of the City of Hogansville and shall be persons who have demonstrated special interest, experience or education in history, architecture or the preservation of historic resources.

Members shall serve three-year terms. In order to achieve staggered terms, initial appointments shall be: one member for one year; three members for two years; and three members for three years. Members shall not receive a salary, although they may be reimbursed for expenses. Members may be reappointed.

SECTION 4:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5:

This ordinance, after adoption by th	e Council and upon approval by the Mayor, shall
become effective immediately.
