



WORK SESSION

A Work Session of the Hogansville City Council was held Monday, February 3, 2020. Mayor Stankiewicz called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Stankiewicz; Council Member Reginald Jackson, Council Member Mandy Neese, Council Member Mark Ayers, and Council Member Toni Striblin. Also present were City Attorney Jeff Todd, Interim City Manager Lisa Kelly, Planning and Community Development Director Lynne Miller, and Chief of Police Brian Harr. Council Member Marichal Price not present for tonight's meeting.

BUSINESS

1. Davenport & Company Presentation regarding MEAG Leaseback. Courtney Rogers and Doug Gephart of Davenport & Company presented a report on City finances, including options on how to unwind the MEAG leaseback. Copy of their report is attached as part of the permanent record for this meeting. Discussion followed.

2. Community Development Block Grant – Broadband.

Motion: Council Member Striblin moved to stop work on a CDBG Innovative grant application due February 14, 2020 for broadband development in Hogansville. The motion was seconded by Council Member Jackson.

Discussion: Interim City Manager Kelly explained that CDBG projects require target areas with low-to-moderate resident incomes; however, AT&T is now providing fiber in Hogansville's low-mod neighborhoods.
