Residential Sanitation Guidelines: A draft document has been created that outlines the city's household and bulk pickup service. The document includes a holiday schedule as well as master pickup schedule. The document has been shared with C&C Sanitation, which is reviewing it for accuracy based on its route schedule. Once official, the document will be published and included in a future utility bill mailing.

Holiday Decorations: Public Works staff is in the process of taking down and storing the Christmas decorations.

Cemetery Cleanup: A request has been made to secure a Troup County inmate crew to assist with cleanup of the city cemetery and litter throughout Hogansville.

Church Street: The erosion on Church Street has been addressed by Crawford Grading & Pipeline, Inc. Work included re-grading and re-grassing of the bank as well as installation of ground cover matting for stabilization.

Staffing: Administrative staff together with the water and streets superintendents conducted panel interviews for four open positions in the city: two in streets and one each in water and wastewater treatment. Job offers are being made this week to include conditional employment offer letters.

Maple Street: A guard rail has been installed for motoring and pedestrian safety at the creek on Maple Street closest to Taliaferro Drive. This addresses the steep drop-off alongside the roadway.
