**Future City Hall Building:** There was a delay for the contractor starting the roof replacement of the former PNC Bank building due to *The Walking Dead* series shoot followed by wet weather. Roof Depot Pros is expected to commence work this week.

**Elm Street Bridge:** Closure of Elm Street and replacement of the bridge is delayed due to a backlog on the production of the double-barrel concrete culvert.

**Waste Water Treatment Plant Expansion:** P.F. Moon and Company began mobilizing equipment last week for the USDA-funded project. The contractor moved in its long-reach forklift, bulldozer, and excavator along with its office trailer last week. They are ready for the ceremonial groundbreaking with the Mayor and Council once an agreed upon date and time is established.

**Water and Sewerage System Improvements:** The contractors for the Phase IV CDBG 2017 project has begun work in the city. Hogansville received a grant to improve water and sewer lines in low- to moderate-income neighborhoods. Crawford Grading will be replacing the city-owned portion of the water and sewer lines within rights-of-ways and easements. Some residents may also have their privately-owned water and sewer lines beyond the right-of-way and easements replaced to within five-feet of their homes under the federal grant program. Water and sewer service may be temporarily unavailable while a service line is being replaced. The City is not responsible for water and sewer lines of private property. After construction, maintenance of the service lines becomes the responsibility of the homeowner.
