Regular Meeting - April 3, 2023

Meeting held at Hogansville City Hall, 111 High Street, Hogansville GA 30230

<u>Call to Order, Invocation and Pledge</u>: Mayor Jake Ayers called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. Present were Mayor Ayers and Council Members Michael Taylor, Matthew Morgan, Mandy Neese and Mark Ayers. Also present were City Manager Lisa Kelly, Police Chief Jeff Sheppard, Planning & Development Director Lynne Miller and City Attorney Alex Dixon. Council Member Toni Striblin was absent. An invocation by Mayor Ayers and pledge of allegiance followed the call to order.

Consent Agenda

Presentation

Pioneer Youth Executive Director Emily Abraham provided an overview of this non-profit drop-in program for kids aged 7-17. The program that started in January 2022 with 1-2 youth dropping in daily; and now sees 30-50 kids each day, Monday – Friday, 2:30 pm – 6 pm. The program offers mentoring, tutoring, basketball, soccer, free dinners, cooking and nutrition counseling and other activities from the youth building on Granite Street. Always looking for adults to work with the kids.
